- Sommelier's Table at cellar dining


## Day 3

### Loch Lomond: Cameron House

This morning take a cruise on stunning Loch Lomond:

The loch is 24.5 miles (39 km) long, the largest freshwater loch in Scotland. It has more than 30 islands, the largest of which is Inchmurrin.

## Day 5

### West Highlands: Inverloch Castle Hotel

Set off, through The Trossachs National Park to **Glencoe** and **Ben Nevis**, the highest mountain in the British Isles at 4,400 feet. You are in the heart of the Scottish Highlands here and it is breathtakingly beautiful.

## Day 6

### West Highlands: Inverloch Castle Hotel

Make your way to the ancient and beautiful **Isle of Skye**. Talisker, one of Scotland's most famous whiskies, has its distillery on Skye. On land or water, Skye is a wildlife haven.

### John O'Groats: Ackergill Tower Castle
